## Financial Aid Update

Students apply for California and federal financial aid by completing the online FAFSA. Cal-Grants also require the submission of the student's GPA for 10<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup> grades. Submission of the GPA will be completed electronically\* for all high school seniors on Feb 15<sup>th</sup>, 2017.

If you want to apply for the Cal-Grant, please provide the student's social security number to ensure the GPA & FAFSA match up and avoid delayed disbursement of funds!
