### **Financial Aid Update**

Students apply for California and federal financial aid by completing the online FAFSA. Cal-Grants also require the submission of the student GPA for 10<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup> grades. This year submission of the GPA will be completed electronically for all high school seniors by Feb 15<sup>th</sup>, 2016.
