Cuesta Priority Registration And Promise Scholarship

To receive priority registration for the fall semester you will need to:

If you have completed the above steps by May 19th, you are invited to attend the **Cuesta orientation on Tuesday, May 23rd from 1:30 -3:30** in the PBHS computer lab. If you do not have **priority registration**, you will not be able to register for your classes until late June.

The **deadline** for applying for the **Cuesta Promise** (free tuition for the 2017-2018 school year) is the **1st of August**. The required steps are to **complete the above requirements plus file for FAFSA or the Dream Act and apply online for the Promise scholarship.**
