If you will be attending Cuesta August 2017, the Cuesta Promise requires filing the 2016-2017 FAFSA or Dream Application.

The FAFSA is a joint application for federal and state financial aid. The Dream Application is for State of California financial aid such as the Board of Governor's Waiver and Cal-Grants available to non-residents.
