### State Standardized Testing

All 11th graders will be participating with the SBAC: the new computer-based tests that have replaced STAR. There will be several hours of training involved; students will receive credit hours for the time they spend. Training begins May 2; math testing will be the week of May 9; followed by English testing the week of May 16<sup>th</sup>. Makeup tests will be scheduled if the student is absent.
