## Student Financial Aid 2019-2020

If you will be attending Cuesta **August 2019**, the **Cuesta Promise** requires filing the 2019-2020 FAFSA or Dream Application.

The FAFSA is a joint application for federal and state financial aid.

The Dream Application is for non-residents to apply for State of California financial aid such as the Promise Grant (previously known as the BOG Waiver) and the Cal-Grant.

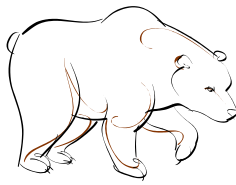
**March 2<sup>nd</sup> is deadline for the state Cal-Grants.**
